As a reminder – please err on the side of caution: If you think you or someone from your family or household have been exposed to COVID please stay at home and listen through the phone patch.

The Brush Prairie board has put together a return to church plan with limited capacity in accordance with the phase 3 Religious Organization Covid-19 Requirements. Attendance at church of 50% capacity is now allowed. Seating is primarily in the sanctuary with overflow in the lobby and in the upstairs Sunday school rooms. The ushers will continue to seat all attendees and release all attendees to help maintain proper social distancing.

Before attending a church service:

- Perform a health check of yourself and your children. Those with a fever above 100.4F or any other signs of illness should stay home for at least three days.
- You should stay home for 14 days if you have tested positive for COVID 19 or been in close proximity to a someone with a positive COVID test.

To minimize the spread of COVID infections or exposure at the church building:

- Members of the same household are encouraged to enter the Sanctuary at the same time so they can be seated together.
- Six foot spacing between members of different households is mandatory. Ushers will direct each household where to sit. After the service the ushers will also direct the exiting so please remain seated until your bench is released.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be in the lobby for use on arrival.
- Use the rear lobby doors for entering and exiting the sanctuary.
- Face coverings are required for anyone 5 years of age and older for both inside and outside while on church property. It is also recommended to encourage your younger children to wear them if possible. Face coverings need to remain on both inside and outside on the church grounds. This includes during singing.
- We ask that people self-monitor and stay home if they have any signs of illness or fever. Individuals at higher risk or otherwise uncomfortable attending in-person service are encouraged to continue attending services via the telephone patch.
- Church cleaning and disinfection of all areas in use will take place after each church event.
