Sunday School Plan

General

- Sunday School will begin Sunday, September 20.
- Class sessions will be held 10:00-10:45 am
- See the curriculum for the schedule of class dates. Copies of the curriculum for each grade may be obtained from your student's teacher(s).
- Families bringing children to Sunday School are welcome to visit outside while class is in session. During cold/inclement weather, the basement may be used.
- Students and teachers are encouraged to wear face coverings and observe social distancing.

Students

While we continue to have limited attendance, the following will attend Sunday School each week:

- Children of families scheduled to be at church as part of the weekly rotation
- Children of teachers scheduled to teach that Sunday
- Children of those helping conduct the church service (Preachers, hymn leaders, Laestadius reader, ushers, & phone/sound operators)
- All students in the 9th grade are encouraged to attend each week.
(If the 9th grade student's family isn't scheduled to attend, one parent should bring their child and may also bring their other Sunday School-aged children for Sunday School and church.)

Children not included in the above groups should be taught the weekly lesson at home.

Suggestions/Options for teaching at home:

- Set aside a specific time to focus on Sunday School
- Refer to the grade-specific curriculum to see the weekly topics of study
- Discuss one or more of the objectives shown on the curriculum
- Study/memorize portions of the catechism (the Creed, Commandments, Lord's Prayer, etc.)
- Families with children in multiple grades will need to adapt the lessons to accommodate children of various ages.

Sunday School Teachers

- Teachers are asked to coordinate among themselves to ensure that there are two teachers present in each class each week.
- If a teacher needs to come help teach on a Sunday when they are not scheduled to attend church, the teacher (and their Sunday School-aged children) are free to stay and attend church that week. Consider sitting in the basement for the church service that Sunday.
- Teachers are encouraged to spend a short time at the beginning of each session reviewing the previous week's lesson.
